They also try to give those who spend their lives on the streets, without access to washing facilities, with what we would consider one of the basics of daily life - a change of underwear. The shelter is therefore always in need of clean, new boxer shorts and have asked if we can help provide these. During October, there will be a box in the vestibule for donations of new men's boxer shorts of any size/brand/colour. If you would prefer to make a small financial contribution towards the purchase of boxers, please note that all pennies placed in the 'collecting loo' in October will be put towards this worthy cause. Your small change will make a huge difference to the lives and dignity of those in need.*
