Many of the children in Malawi who are fed by the Mary's Meals project come to school without the basic tools for learning. Giving them a backpack, filled with essential items helps them to get the most out of their education. For many of these children this backpack will be the first gift they have ever received. You can donate a filled rucksack, an empty rucksack or any of the individual items on the list below. Only the toiletries have to be new - everything else can be a recycled item in good condition. Please leave your donations in the box in the vestibule over the summer months.*

- *Rucksack or School bag (please don't use a drawstring sports bag)*
- *Notepad*
- *Pencils, crayons*
- *Eraser, ruler, sharpener, pencil case*
- *Towel*
- *Shorts or skirt, T-shirt or dress (for school aged child)*
- *Flipflops or sandals*
- *Soap, toothbrush, toothpaste (must be new)*
- *Small ball*
- *Spoon*

Please do not include any liquids (including liquid soap), sweets, extra gifts or money. All the backpacks are checked to ensure they only contain those items on the list. This avoids problems at Customs and ensures fairness when they are distributed.
